

WALK

creep - move slowly and carefully in order to avoid being heard or noticed. **skradać się, pełzać**

tread - to walk or step on something **nadepnąć**

run - move at a speed faster than a walk. **biegać**

speed - move quickly. **pędzić, gnać**

stride - walk with long, decisive steps in a specified direction. **kroczyć, przekraczać**

come - move or travel towards or into a place thought of as near or familiar to the speaker. **przyjść, przyjechać**

leave- go away from place. **odchodzić, opuszczać**

hike - a long walk or walking tour. **wędrować pieszo**

wander - to travel from place to place, especially on foot, without a particular direction or purpose. **wędrować, włóczyć się, szwędąć**

go - to travel or move to another place. **iść, pójść**

step- a particular movement or set of movements performed with your feet when you are dancing, a short movement made by putting one foot in front of the other **stąpać, nadepnąć**

track - follow the trail or movements of (someone or something), typically in order to find them or note their course. **śledzić, tropić**

circuit - move all the way around (a place or thing). **okrążyć, krążyć**

pace - a step that you take when you walk or run. chodzić, kroczyć **przemierzać miarowym tempem**

march - to walk somewhere quickly and in a determined, confident, or angry way **maszerować**

pass - to go past something. **wymijać, przechodzić, wyprzedzać**

stroll - to walk without hurrying, often for pleasure **przechadzać się, spacerować**

saunter - to walk in a slow and relaxed way **przechadzać się, spacerować**

ramble - to go for a long walk in the countryside for enjoyment **przechadzać się, spacerować, wędrować**

amble - to walk in a slow relaxed way **iść spokojnym krokiem**

plod - to walk with slow heavy steps **wlec się, posuwać się z trudem, ciężko stąpać**

swagger - to walk in a proud and confident way

peace **iść dumnym krokiem**

tiptoe - walk with only your toes on the ground **chodzić na palcach**

trek - to walk somewhere slowly and with no enthusiasm, for example because you are tired. **długo wędrować, podróżować**

toddle - if a very young child toddles, it walks with short steps that are not steady because it is just learning to walk **niepewny chód (dziecko)**

mince - to walk with very short steps in a way that is not natural **tuptać**

trudge - to walk somewhere with slow heavy steps **brnąć, iść z trudem**

traipse - to walk around slowly and without a specific direction **włóczyć się, wlec się**

saunter - walk in a slow, relaxed manner. **spacerować, połazić**

mosey - to walk somewhere very slowly, often without a purpose **wałęsać się, chadzać, przechadzać się**

wobble - to rock slightly from side to side, or to make something do this **chodzić chwiejnym krokiem**

sashay - to walk somewhere in a relaxed and confident manner **chodzić dumnie, kroczyć**

stagger - to walk in an uncontrolled way, as if you are going to fall over **ciągnąć się**

shuffle - to walk slowly and noisily without lifting your feet **szurać, powłóczyć nogami**
